## Office Order COVID -19 Advisories

Date: April 24, 2021

In continuation of the office order dated 23 April 2021 and as more positive cases of COVID-19 are being reported in the campus of Arunachal University of Studies, the following advisories are issued for strict compliance by all concerned.

- 1. All offline classes at AUS are suspended with immediate effect and until further notice.
- All classes will be conducted in the online mode following the protocols that were in force during first wave of COVID-19. This process should be initiated as soon as possible. The IT wing of the University is advised to make necessary arrangements immediately to facilitate the conduct of online classes.
- 3. The predicament of students and research scholars to pursue and complete their academic assignments is understandable. However, health should be the top priority for all of us, particularly in the face of highly infectious virus with evolving mutants. There is no place better than home for getting a safe environment and, if required, for care for the unfortunate potential victims of the pandemic. Therefore, keeping in mind, the well-being and safety of all, the hostel residents, it is advised, where feasible, shall leave for their native places in order to stay safe, and also help curb the virulent spread of COVID-19 virus.
- 4. The faculty are advised to work from home until further orders.
- 5. The administrative and supporting staff, however, will attend duties normally unless they have come in direct contact with any individuals who have tested positive for the virus or showing symptoms of infection.
- 6. Wearing of face mask, sanitization of the hands and social distancing are mandatory in the campus. Appropriate disciplinary action including fine shall be imposed if these instructions are found violated by anyone.
- 7. Employees and their family members, and students who are tested positive or under home isolation/quarantine, if any, must inform with supporting document immediately to the Administration.
- 8. Campus residents must maintain a minimum distance of 6 feet in public places and no gathering is permitted in the vicinity of AUS.
- 9. Installation and use of Aarogya Setu App is advised to all.
- 10. The Administrative Officer of AUS may sanitize the premises including the residential quarters periodically using the disinfectants received from the Noida office (dilution: 25 ml per 15 L).

These advisories would be applicable with immediate effect and will remain in force until further communication.
