



AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION BETWEEN CHIANG MAI UNIVERSITY, CHIANG MAI, THAILAND

ARUNACHAL UNIVERSITY OF STUDIES NAMSAI, ARUNACHAL PRADESH, INDIA

AND

Chiang Mai University, Chiang Mai, Thailand (hereinafter referred as CMU), and Arunachal University of Studies, Namsai, Arunachal Pradesh, India (hereinafter referred as AUS) conclude this agreement in recognition of mutual benefits arising from the establishment of effective academic relations. The purpose of this agreement is to promote scientific relations through academic collaboration between both institutions.

- 1. CMU and AUS agree to promote and develop this academic collaboration by the following mean:
 - (a) Exchange of staff members, undergraduate and graduate students
 - (b) Staff development
 - (c) Visiting professorship and scientific visits
 - (d) Execution of joint research projects
 - (e) Provision of lectures, seminars, and conferences
 - (f) Exchange of data, documents, research materials and academic information
 - (g) Other mutually beneficial projects which may be defined from time to time
- Details of the implementation for any particular exchange resulting from the agreement shall be consulted with each other, and develop specific plans for collaboration in any of the ways mentioned above.

- This agreement may be effective from the date of signing for a period of five years and may be revised or modified within the period of its validity by mutual consent. It may also be terminated within that period by either institution by giving the other institution not less than six months' notice of its intention to terminate it. In case of termination, the programs or the activities that have already been approved by both parties by the date of the written notice shall be allowed completion under the conditions of this agreement.
- This agreement will be extended beyond that period after discussion by representatives of both institutions. The discussion can begin any time before the final six months of the initial period of the agreement.
